

Anxiety About For Darwin Clergyman

Was In Bombed Ship In 1943

Darwin, May 20.—The former Methodist Minister at Darwin, Rev. Leonard S. Kentish, B.A.B.D., has not been seen since he was picked out of the Arafura Sea, near Wessel Island, by a Japanese float plane in January of 1943. He was a passenger in a naval supply ship, Patricia Cam, when the vessel was bombed by a plane. The Patricia Cam was sunk and there were some casualties. The plane alighted near the survivors and Rev. Kentish was ordered aboard at revolver point, but the others drifted to a radio post. Rev. Kentish's wife who lives in Brisbane is anxious to get in touch with any former P.O.W. who may have met him.
