

Executed By Japs

The clerical secretary and treasurer of the Methodist Oversea Missions (Mr A. C. Hull) who is visiting Wynyard, announced yesterday that the Rev L. N. Kentish, chairman of the North Australian mission district who was captured by the Japs in 1943, was executed.

Mr Kentish was aboard the patrol vessel Patricia Cam when it was sunk by Jap aircraft. It was known that he was picked up by an enemy float craft.

It has been officially advised that he reached Dobo on April 13, 1943, and was executed on May 4, 1943.
